Summary For Interpreting Parables

- Look for repetition in threes
- Look for the situation or need that prompted Jesus to give the parable
- Look for the main point or punch line at the end of the parable that matches the situation or need
- Do any cultural studies if necessary
- Use cross reference, remember, Jesus gave some parables more than once and changed them a bit to fit a different situation or need
- Interpret details properly and beware of over spiritualizing

I. HOMEWORK

Read Luke 12:16-21 the Parable of the Rich Fool

- 1. What is the situation or need, which led to Jesus' giving the parable? "*Tell my brother to Share the inheritance with me*" vs. 13.
- 2. What is the main point in the parable, which addresses the main problem, situation, or need? Greed. *"Even when one has an abundance does his life consist of his possessions"* vs. 15.
- 3. What cultural customs or background information is helpful in interpreting the parable (if any)? **Not really any. Greed and hoarding transcends culture.**
- 4. Is the parable given anywhere else? At the same time? To the same group of people? To meet the same need, problem, or situation? **No**
- 5. What details have spiritual meaning and which do not?
 - a. **Rich fool = anyone who is not rich toward God and greedy.**
 - b. **Possessions = any worldly treasures or God given gifts**
- 6. How does the main point of this parable apply to you personally?
 - a. **Don't be greedy.**
 - b. **Don't think that life consists of possessions.**
 - c. **Don't let the world fool you into lusting after the things of the World as if they define what life is.**
 - d. Don't presume upon God by thinking you are in control of your soul.
 - e. Don't presume upon God by thinking you have many years to live.
 - f. Use your earthly possessions to do God's will.
 - g. Treat every day as if it were your last.
 - h. Be generous with what God has given you.

- i. Give God the glory for what you have.
- j. Remember that life begins after we die and this life is not all there is.
- k. Remember that you will be judged in the future by God for how you act here and now.
